

NSW Appaloosa Championships

Rules & Regulations

1. No refunds after closing date.
- 2 The show will be run under AAA LTD and HSAA rules. All Halter in western attire.
3. The committee reserves the right to alter the program or order of events .
4. .Horses must be registered with the AAA Ltd
5. All owners, competitors ,strappers. and/or handlers must be current financial members of AAA Ltd to be covered by insurance.
- 6 Electric fences or make shift yards are not to be erected by order of Dubbo City Council
- 7 .All dogs must be under control at all times tied up or on a leash. Dogs must be registered with the Councils grounds man on arrival. Any dog found loose will be impounded by council.
- 8 .Leadline ;;;. Youth competing in this event cannot compete in any other ridden event.
9. Youth Walk/Trot;;; Youth competing in these events cannot compete in any other ridden event
- 10 Limited Amateur can enter both the Limited Amateur and the Open Amateur .Limited Amateur Hi Point will be calculated on the Limited Amateur classes only.
- 11 2 & 3 yr old horses entering a Junior event cannot enter a 2or 3 yr old event eg. a 3yr old entering a Junior horse trail cannot enter the 3 yr old trail or visa versa.
12. Dressage horses can compete in two consecutive levels. No more than 3 tests can be ridden in a day, exception to this rules is the two youth and the two Amateur tests.
- 13 .Hunter in Hand; Dressage whips are allowed. Yearlings and 2 yr olds may either be shown in a bridle or a plain leather halter . 3yr olds and over must be in a bridle. ' Y' leads or reins are acceptable.
14. Most Colourful ;; No B or BT registered horses allowed in this event.
It will be judged 60% colour 40% confirmation , action , substance, quality and manners.
15. Hi Points will be calculated 6,5,4,3,2,1 system .tie breakers as per rule book.
16. Youth who are competing on more than 2 horses in youth events can nominate a maximum of 2 horses towards their Hi Points awards for the show. Nominations must be made prior to the commencement of the show with the show secretary. Only the highest placing from the youth events will be counted towards Hi Point awards.
17. Amateurs who are competing on more than 2 horses in the Amateur Junior events or Amateur Senior events can nominate a maximum of 2 horses per age group ,whose points will count towards Amateur Junior or Amateur Senior Hi Point Awards .Nominations must be made prior to the commencement of the show with the show secretary .Only the highest placings from Amateur events will be counted towards the Hi Point Awards
- 18.Entry to the ground is only from Friday 20th ,anyone wishing to arrive before must arrange with the showground management, to enter the ground .Payment of stables and camping on arrival before the Friday 20th must be made on arrival to showground manager.
