



This program is for everybody who rides an Appaloosa, be it Endurance, Hacking, Showing, Pony Club, Trail Riding, Campdrafting etc! Riders are rewarded at certain levels of achievement for hours in the saddle on one or more of their own horses. The hours are calculated on the rider, you can therefore clock up your hours on more than one horse.

At certain levels you will obtain recognition and reward for your efforts and your achievement will be published in the Australian Appaloosa Journal.

To become involved in this program you will need to contact the AAA Ltd Office to obtain log sheets. As you complete your sheets, you return them to the Office for recording.

Of course there are some regulations:-

1. All horses participating in the Saddle Log Program must be coloured, 14 hands minimum **OR** registered with the AAA Ltd.
2. Recorded hours must be on official AAA Ltd forms.
3. If you are not a AAA Ltd member then a once-a-year \$15 recording fee will apply. Year calculated from 1st August to 31st July regardless of commencement date.
4. As hours are permanent, fee need not be paid if rider NOT participating for that particular year.
5. Hours are calculated from date payment is received.
6. Fee is non-refundable.
7. There is no limit to the number of horses per rider.
8. Minimum age of horses 3 years.
9. The program is based on an honour system, but random checks may be carried out by the AAA Ltd Office.
10. Awards are obtained at
 - 100 hours (patch)
 - 250 hours (cap)
 - 500 hours (cap + chevron)
 - 750 hours (polo shirt or similar)
 - 1000 hours (saddle cloth)
11. An annual award will be given to the horse with the highest number of hours for each year. However this award will only apply if your horse is registered with the AAA Ltd and you are a current financial member.
