Regulations -

Rule 10.3 - Amateur Rules

- (a) 1. An Amateur, for the purpose of this rule book, is any person who is no longer eligible to show in youth classes and has not been a professional for the last three (3) years.
 2. A 50 & over Amateur, for the purpose of this rule book, is any Amateur who is 50 years of age or older.
- (e) All applications for Amateur status must be completed on official forms supplied by the AAA Ltd. Renewal is due 1st August each year. For endorsement of Amateur 50 and over on any Amateur card the Amateur must upon turning 50 supply proof of age and any prescribed fee to the AAA Ltd Office and the Amateur's card will be endorsed as eligible for 50 & over classes. Before any Amateur 50 & Over competes in any Amateur 50 & Over events they must hold the appropriate endorsement on their AAAA membership card.

- (l) AAAA Points & Awards
ii insert after 3rd paragraph :

AAAA Yearly High Point Amateur 50 & Over; all points earned by the 50 & Over Amateur at State and National shows will be automatically recorded and all other points sheets from any recognised shows must be forwarded to the assigned scorer within 30 days accompanied by a copy of the program. Points as per AAA Ltd Rule book (Rule 5.2)
