2011/2012 End of Year High Point Award Rules:

National Awards

Qualifying

NSW/ACT, VIC, SA & QLD Only – Minimum of twenty (20) points must have been gained in recognised events. Five (5) of which must be “A” class points

TAS, NT & WA Only – Minimum of fifteen (15) points must have been gained in recognised events. Five (5) of which must be “A” class points.

Points

National Awards will be calculated from National, State, “AA”, “A” and “B” class shows. “C” Class shows are awarded ROM Only points and are therefore excluded.

Eligible Classes

Yearling Versatility - Calculated on Hunter In Hand, Led Trail, Lungeline, Led Hack, Suitability For Dressage and Halter (Yearling Only). **Yearlings are not eligible for any other performance category.**

2 Year Old Performance Horse – Calculated on Led Trail, Lungeline and Hunter In Hand from 1/8 to 31/12 ONLY and 2yo Ridden Performance Events from 1/1 to 31/7 ONLY.

Traditional English Horse - Calculated on Dressage, Hack, Led Hack, Show Jumping, Hunter Hack, Working Hunter and Eventing.

Games/Novelties Horse - Calculated on Barrel, Keyhole, Stakes Race, Stump Race, any Pony Club novelties as sanctioned by the Pony Club Australia Rule Book.

Working Cattle Horse - Calculated on Working Cow Horse, Calf Roping, Steer Wrestling, Cutting, Campdraft, Steer Daubing, Station Cutting and Steer Roping.

Trail Riding Horse - Calculated on Australian Trail Horse Riders Association sanctioned Trail Rides only.

Endurance Horse - Calculated on Equestrian Australia sanctioned Endurance Rides only.

Youth competing in Youth 13yrs & under may nominate for both categories, but may only claim points from 1 category per show.

Amateur Halter Horse - Calculated from points gained in Appaloosa Amateur Halter Classes only. Points gained in Open Breed Amateur Halter will not be counted.

Limited Amateur - Calculated from Limited Amateur Classes held at National and State Shows only.

Amateur Masters - Calculated from Amateur Masters and Select Amateur* Class points only. The Amateur must have a properly notarised Amateur Card to be eligible to compete in these classes. * **Select Amateur Classes from AQHA Shows only.**

General Rules

The points gained by a gelding when shown as a colt (prior to gelding) do not accumulate. The points must restart once shown as a gelding. Geldings who gain points whilst being shown with a PC Registration Number will not be included. Please note: This rule applies only to End of Year High Point Awards and **not** ROM's etc.

State Awards

State Awards will be awarded for NSW/ACT, VIC, QLD/NT, SA, TAS, WA.

Qualifying

NSW/ACT, VIC, SA & QLD Only – Minimum of fifteen (15) points must have been gained in recognised events.

TAS, NT & WA Only – Minimum of ten (10) points must have been gained in recognised events.

Points

Points for State Awards will be calculated from "AA", "A" and "B" class shows. National Show Points are excluded, State Show Points from the State in which the Owner of the Horse, Amateur or Youth Resides will be included. All other State Shows are excluded. "C" Class shows are awarded ROM Only points and are therefore excluded.

Eligible Classes

Yearling Versatility - Calculated on Hunter In Hand, Led Trail, Lungeline, Led Hack, Suitability For Dressage and Halter (Yearling Only). **Yearlings are not eligible for any other Performance Category.**

Youth competing in Youth 13yrs & under may nominate for both categories, but may only claim points from 1 category per show.

Amateur Masters - Calculated from Amateur Masters and Select Amateur* Class points only. The Amateur must have a properly notarised Amateur Card to be eligible to compete in these classes. * **Select Amateur Classes from AQHA Shows only.**

Amateur Halter Horse - Calculated from points gained in Appaloosa Amateur Halter Classes only. Points gained in Open Breed Amateur Halter will not be counted.
