

Rule Change

Rule 3.24 - Deceased Horses

From: - When a registered Appaloosa dies, the owner must notify the AAA Ltd of the date of death and return the Certificate of Registration to the Office. The records and Certificate will be marked deceased and the Certificate will be returned to the owner. A deceased horse cannot be registered with the Association.

To: - When a registered Appaloosa dies the registered owner must notify the AAA Ltd by a declaration in writing that the horse is deceased and the AAA Ltd will note all records accordingly. All horses over 30 years of age will be deemed to be deceased and records noted accordingly unless the AAA Ltd is notified by the registered owner in writing that the horse is not deceased. A deceased horse cannot be registered with the association.
